

UNOFFICIAL MINUTES - June 1, 2021

A special meeting of the Inman City council was held Tuesday, June 1, 2021, at 7:00 a.m. at the City Office. In attendance were Don Froese, Mike Gilzinger, Scott Schriener, Dennis Schroeder, Dave Thiessen, and Jim Toews. A quorum was present. Toews called the meeting to order at 7:05 a.m. Others present were Rod Boerger, Larry Froese, Diane Miller, and Barbara Tuxhorn.

The special meeting was called by the mayor at the request of Froese, Gilzinger, and Schriener to discuss provision of water and sewer utility services for 779 Cherokee. After discussion of a proposal from Vogts-Parga to provide water and sewer service to the west side of the property at 779 Cherokee, Thiessen motioned that the city pay the costs for extension of water and sewer utility services to the property when a business developer is located by Froese. No contract was entered at this time. When a contract is entered, engineering fees will be divided equally between the sewer and water funds. Schriener seconded. Passed 5-0.
